

- Many CC Biotech Programs are former Career Technical Education Programs
 - Often well funded and well equipped
 - Example: \$250 million per year to CC CTE & additional city bond funds
- NSF Grant connects these CC Biotech Programs
 - Administered by Austin CC in Texas
- All CC Biotech programs have industry advisory committees – consider joining one near you

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
