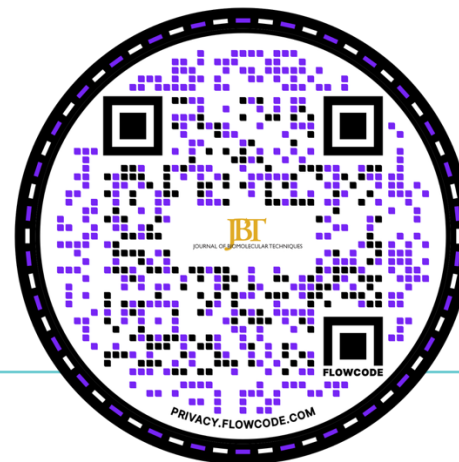

All Chapter Meeting attendees who are not yet ABRF members are eligible for ***complimentary*** membership through 2026

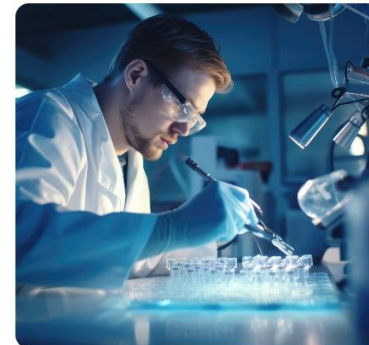
